Music Composition: A New Method of Harmony is a great title authored by Carl E. Gardner and intended to be a textbook for use by teachers and students of music. Gardner opens Music Composition with an appeal to music teachers to deviate from the common pedagogical strategies of the day. The author believes that too often young music students are taught on a very strict, almost mathematical, basis, and that this method hinders the development of those not inclined to learn in this way. The purpose of the text is thus to present a new method for teaching students that allows the student to compose music without thought of technical and grammatical rules. Gardner s work is divided into two parts, with part one presenting the fundamentals of music composition and part two offering a more challenging curriculum. The book itself is a mix of text and sheet music, ensuring that the student will be doing as much playing as reading. Music Composition is a thorough but accessible treatise on the subject matter.
